

From the trenches to the web - Europe's "hidden" history on Europeana 1914-1918

[Europeana 1914-1918](#) started in 2011 as a pan-European engagement project concerning WW1, with a focus on the human aspects of the conflict. The thematic collection brings together resources from major European projects and institutions. The result is an online archive that allows the national collections of libraries to sit beside personal stories and treasures and important film archives, thus offering a unique perspective of the First World War. The related crowd-sourcing initiative [Transcribathon Europeana 1914-1918](#) offers online tools to unlock important and unpublished testimonies for future generations by transcribing handwritten texts from the collection.
