

Commemorating together 1918/19: 30 exhibitions in France, Germany and Switzerland

Different commemorative cultures between European countries influenced the profile of museums especially since the last century. This is why the cross-border museum network in the Upper Rhine valley regularly tries to provide knowledge about the neighboring countries and their history. 100 years after the end of the First World War it presents 30 interconnected temporary exhibitions in France, Germany and Switzerland. The exhibition in the Three-Countries-Museum gives the general overview of the three countries in 1918 and the following years. The other exhibitions focus on special aspects of national, regional or thematic interest of that time.

The lecture describes scopes, difficulties and results of the process of 4 years to realize this cross-border project and the reaction of the public so far.
